**APPOINTMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT EVALUATOR/AUDITOR  
FOR THE QUALITY STANDARDS SYSTEM FOR ACTIVITIES  
OF BOTH GOVERNMENTAL AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES UNDER ITS  
AUTHORITY**

**WHEREAS**, under Section I of Letter of Instructions No. 1404 dated May 1, 1984, the Maritime Training Council is established to give effect to the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers;

**WHEREAS**, The Philippine Government is a Party to the STCW 1978 Convention and by international protocol bound to give effect to said Convention;

**WHEREAS**, Regulation I/8 of the Convention stipulates " Each Party shall ensure that:

1. in accordance with the provisions of Section A-I/8 of the STCW Code, all training, assessment of competence, certification, endorsement and revalidation activities carried out by non-governmental agencies or entities under its authority are continuously monitored through a quality standards system to ensure achievement of defined objectives, including those concerning the qualifications and experience of instructors and assessors; and
2. where governmental agencies or entities perform such activities, there shall be a quality standards system.

**WHEREAS**, it is the national goal to ensure effective and efficient implementation and administration of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended;






