DESIGNATING THE PHILIPPINE MARITIME ASSESSMENT AND TESTING FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL SERVICES TO THE MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 6, S-2000 provides for the creation of a National Assessment Center under the supervision and control of the Maritime Training Council, and pending approval of the regular plantilla of the Council, the latter shall designate a non-stock/non-profit organization to provide technical services to the said Center.

WHEREAS, the MTC Secretariat pursuant to Section 4 of the above-mentioned Resolution has identified the Philippine Maritime Assessment and Testing Foundation, Inc. as the organization to be designated;

WHEREAS, the said Foundation, which is a non-stock and non-profit organization, has the capability and technical expertise to perform the specified responsibility under Sections 2 and 3 of the above-mentioned Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby resolved that:

1. The Philippine Maritime Assessment and Testing Foundation, Inc. [Foundation] is hereby designated as the entity to provide technical services to the National Assessment Center in accordance with Section 1 of MTC Resolution No. 06, Series of 2000;
2. The Foundation shall immediately undertake the responsibilities specified under Sections 2 and 3 of the said Resolution particularly on the issue of documentary evidence in Basic Safety and the Certificate of Proficiency under Chapters V and VI of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended.
