Resolution No. 12

**PROVIDING STANDARDS IN THE EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF MASTERS,  
CHIEF MATES, CHIEF ENGINEER OFFICERS AND SECOND ENGINEER OFFICERS  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 1978 STCW CONVENTION, AS AMENDED**

**WHEREAS**, the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended requires, among others, that Masters, Chief Mates, Chief Engineer Officers and Second Engineer Officers shall have completed an approved education and training before they can be certified as such;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines as a Party to the Convention is committed to introduce a training program to Filipino officers at the management level in order to comply with the education and training requirement of the Convention;

**WHEREAS**, the IMO has validated and published the revised IMO 7.01 for Master and Chief Mate and IMO Model Course 7.02 for Chief Engineer Officer and Second Engineer Officer;


**WHEREAS**, MTC Resolution No. 4, S-1995 provides for the adoption of the IMO Model Courses as standards in the training for Filipino seafarers.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the above premises, resolved that :

1. The IMO Model Course 7.01 for Master and Chief Mate and IMO Model Course 7.02 for Chief Engineer Officer and Second Engineer Officer are adopted as the approved standards in the education and training of the Filipino officers at the Management level, respectively;
2. The said model courses shall be included in Annex 1 & 2 of MTC Resolution No. 03, S-1998;
3. The MTC Secretariat, in consultation with CHED, PRC and the Maritime Industry shall conduct the necessary adjustment to the course program as may be considered appropriate and to formulate guidelines for its effective implementation.






