



**RESOLUTION NO. 17**  
**Series of 2000**

**Authorizing Maritime Training Council to collect P 200.00/ certificate issued by the National Assessment Center**

**WHEREAS** the Maritime Training Council, by virtue of Resolution No. 06, Series of 2000, has established a National Assessment Center which is tasked to conduct independent assessment of the competence of seafarers for the issue of certificates required under the 1978 STCW Convention as amended in 1995;


**WHEREAS** pursuant to Resolution No. 08, Series of 1999, the Maritime Training Council is collecting fees for accreditation of course programs, inspection, reinspection and other fees;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Guidelines and Procedures of Assessment for the National Assessment Center as approved by the Maritime Training Council under Resolution No. 11, Series of 2000, and the accompanying workflow in renewing STCW '78 certificates/documents to STCW '95 under Chapter V and VI for existing seafarers at the National Assessment Center, payment of fees is required upon release of the certificate/document issued to the seafarer found qualified as holder of such certificate/document,

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the above premises, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved that the MTC Secretariat shall collect assessment fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) per certificate issued to the seafarer entitled thereto pursuant to the Guidelines and Procedures of Assessment under Resolution No. 11, Series of 2000 and provided that all fees collected herein shall be remitted to the OWWA in accordance with Letter of Instruction No. 1404.
