APPROVAL OF THE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS OF THE MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL SECRETARIAT FOR CURRENT YEAR 2004 FOR ENDORSEMENT TO THE OVERSEAS WORKERS' WELFARE ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, as mandated by Letter of Instruction No. 1404 dated May 1, 1984 the Overseas Workers' Welfare Administration shall allocate funding support to the Maritime Training Council (MTC);

WHEREAS, in the meeting of the Maritime Training Council last 18 February 2004, the proposed funding requirements for the Current Year 2004 amounting to **TWENTY THREE MILLION EIGHTY THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TEN PESOS (Php 23,083,210.00)** presented to the Members for their review and approval;

WHEREAS, the funds being requested shall be funded from the proceeds of the Seafarers' Welfare Fund being managed by OWWA;

RESOLVED, therefore, as it is hereby resolved, that the proposed budget of MTC Secretariat amounting to **TWENTY THREE MILLION EIGHTY THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TEN PESOS (Php 23,083,210.00)** is hereby accepted by the Council and recommended for endorsement to OWWA.


