**APPROVAL OF THE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS OF THE
MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL SECRETARIAT
FOR CURRENT YEAR 2006 FOR ENDORSEMENT TO THE
OVERSEAS WORKERS' WELFARE ADMINISTRATION**

WHEREAS, as amended by Letter of Instruction No. 1404 dated May 1, 1984, the Overseas Workers' Welfare Administration (OWWA) shall allocate funding support to the Maritime Training Council (MTC);

WHEREAS, in the meeting of the MTC on April 27, 2006, the proposed funding requirement for the current Year 2006 amounting to **TWENTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE PESOS (Php 22,327,961)** was presented to the Members for their deliberation and approval;

WHEREAS, the funds being requested shall be funded from the proceeds of the appropriate fund being managed by OWWA;

RESOLVED, therefore, as it is hereby resolved, that the proposed budget of the MTC Secretariat amounting to **TWENTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE PESOS (Php 22,327,961)** is hereby approved by the Council and recommended for endorsement to OWWA.


