**GRANTING THE NATIONAL MARITIME POLYTECHNIC (NMP),
TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (TESDA),
FILIPINO ASSOCIATION FOR MARINERS EMPLOYMENT (FAME)
AND PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF MARITIME TRAINING CENTERS, INC. (PAMTCI)
OBSERVER STATUS IN THE COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Letter of Instruction (LOI) No. 1404 provides that "A *Maritime Training Council shall be established to give effect to the International Convention on the Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers. The Council shall be attached to the Ministry of Labor and Employment for administrative and policy control and shall be composed of the Minister of Labor and Employment as Chairman, and the following as members: the Administrator of the Maritime Industry Authority, the Commandant of Philippine Coast Guard, the Director of the Bureau of Higher Education, the Administrator of the Philippine Overseas Employment Administration, the Administrator of the Welfarefund Administration, the Chairman of the Professional Regulation Commission and one (1) representative from the private sectors, to be appointed by the Chairman.*,"



2. Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)
3. Filipino Association for Mariners Employment (FAME)
4. Philippine Association of Maritime Training Centers, Inc. (PAMTCI)
