APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR ACCREDITATION OF THE *NEW SIMULATOR CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES* AS TRAINING PROVIDER FOR THE MANAGEMENT LEVEL COURSES FOR MARINE DECK AND ENGINEER OFFICER

Whereas, the *NEW SIMULATOR CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES*, an authorized training provider of STCW related courses, organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines with business address at 5/F 2053 Building, Edison Street, Makati City, has applied for accreditation with the Council as training provider for the Management Level Course for Marine Deck and Engineer Officer pursuant to MTC Resolution No. 04, Series 2006.
