APPROVAL OF THE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS OF THE MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL SECRETARIAT FOR CURRENT YEAR 2007 FOR ENDORSEMENT TO THE OVERSEAS WORKERS' WELFARE ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, as amended by Letter of Instruction No. 1404 dated May 1, 1984, the Overseas Workers' Welfare Administration (OWWA) shall allocate funding support to the Maritime Training Council (MTC);

WHEREAS, in the meeting of the MTC on January 19, 2007, the proposed funding requirement for the current Year 2007 amounting to **TWENTY NINE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS (Php 29,849,338)** was presented to the Members for their deliberation and approval;

WHEREAS, the funds being requested shall be funded from the proceeds of the appropriate fund being managed by OWWA.

RESOLVED, therefore, as it is hereby resolved, that the proposed budget of the MTC Secretariat amounting to **TWENTY NINE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS (Php 29,849,338)** is hereby approved by the Council and recommended for endorsement to OWWA.


