RESOLUTION NO. 03 Series of 2008

DESIGNATING FERRIBY MARINE/AJA REGISTRAR AS THE INDEPENDENT EVALUATOR OF THE NATIONAL QUALITY STANDARDS SYTEM (NQSS) FOR COMPLIANCE TO REGULATION I/8 OF THE 1978 STCW CONVENTION, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the quality standards system of Parties to the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended, are subject to independent evaluation at intervals of not more than 5 years by qualified persons who are not involved on the activities concerned;

WHEREAS, the field of application of the quality standards system are the Administration of the certification system, training courses and program, examination and assessment, revalidation and endorsement of certificates;

WHEREAS, the NQSS the implementation of which is in compliance to STCW Regulation I/8 was approved by the Council under Resolution No. 05, S-2007;

WHEREAS, for the compliance of the independent evaluation requirement of the STCW Convention, 5 auditing bodies were invited to submit proposal to act as independent evaluator; but only two (2) signified intention to accept;

WHEREAS, between the two interested auditing bodies, Ferriby Marine/AJA Registrar offered a lower cost for the conduct of independent evaluation besides having submitted a list of more experienced and qualified evaluators.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of the Council under Section I of the Executive Order No. 242 dated May 12, 2000, resolve as it is hereby resolved that Ferriby Marine/AJA Registrar is designated as the independent evaluator for National Quality Standards System in compliance to paragraph 2 of Regulation I/8 of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended;


